iron age: stony VCP briquetage

VCP is an old term and simply means 'Very Coarse Pottery'. Stony VCP briquetage is not as common in Herefordshire as the Droitwich briquetage.

VCP briquetage was present at the iron age settlement at Kenchester¹ and Midsummer Hill hillfort.²
