TNA E 179 118 338 1590 Greytree tax lists

Parishes are gradually being transcribed. Please note that transcribers have done their best with documents often in poor condition and with difficult handwriting; refer to the images of the document in case of doubt.

The Greytree parishes transcribed here were interleaved in with the Wormelow membranes and form only a small part of the whole of Greytree hundred. For each parish, there is a list of names of those liable for tax. The first sum of money next to their name is their 'rateable value'. so to speak, the following sums are the amount they paid (or should have paid). People were rated on 'land' value (terr) or 'goods' (bon) i.e moveable possessions including cash. For each particular tax event – there were a number over the years as money had to be raised for different expenditure - there were different rules. After people were assessed for goods or land, the tax or 'subsidy' was charged according to given rates. The tax was granted in March 1589 (when the year began in April) and was to be paid in four instalments. the first of which was to be collected by November 1590. In fact, the National Archives document reference above is dated 14 October 1590 The full list of Herefordshire E 179 118 records from 1559 to 1630 in the National Archives can be found here. The list below applies to the first payment i.e. in 1590.

Only those owning goods to the value of £3 or more were assessed. at a rate of 20d. per pound for the first and third payments and 12d. per pound for the second and fourth payments. 'Land' tax only applied to those with value of 20s or more and they paid 2s. 8d. for the first and third payments and 16d. per pound for the second and fourth payments. At the bottom of the list of names is the 'sum' of the payments that were to be made.
